Commodore's Message

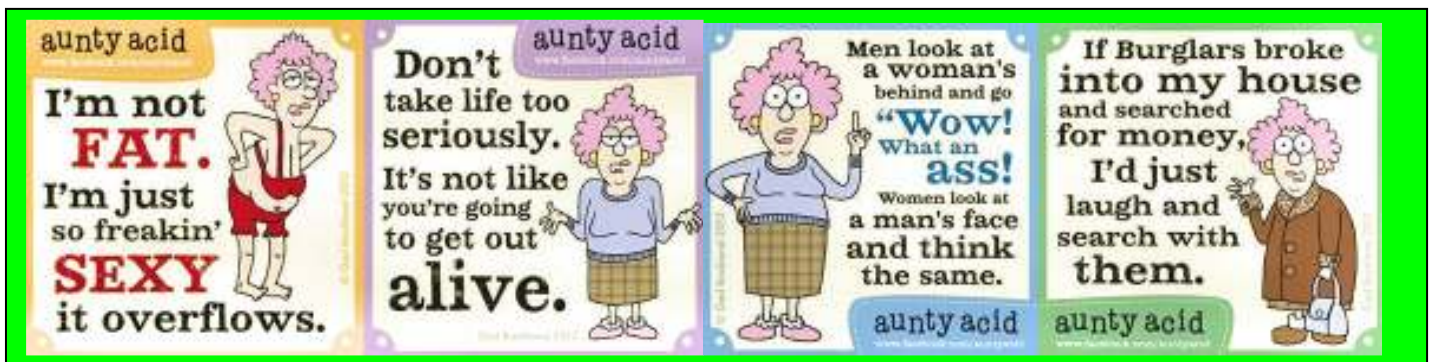
